

Old Meeting House Maintenance and Repairs

- 1950 – Shingled roof (\$700)
- 1955-1957 – Painting and repairs (\$200)
- 1957 – Library partitions removed (installation date unknown).
- 1959 – Painted building (perhaps the \$1060 cost for “painting” without a date)
- 1965 – Removed interior partition; patched clapboards; repaired roof; repaired stairs
- 1966 – Graded all grounds around MH (except ditch by road); seeded lawn
- 1966 – Reset and leveled front granite steps
- 1968 – State filled large ditch in front of MH
- 1969 – Re-plastered walls and ceilings
- 1970 – Added electrical service
- 1970 – Painted interior second floor; re-glazed second-floor windows
- 1970 – Shingled roof: Cedar Shingles on new plywood underlayment (Lake, \$2,800)
- 1970 – Added gravel to driveway
- 1971 – Flags and staffs installed, dedicated to Joseph W. Degen.
- 1979 – (1978?) New foundation and crawl space (RH Davis, Inc. \$40,000)
- 1979 – Painted exterior (MacArthur, \$3,600)
- 1979 – Repairs to clapboards
- 1987 – Painted exterior (Radcliffe, \$4938)
- 1989 – Shingled roof with white cedar shingles (Mountain City Home \$3500)
- 1992 – Installed 2 new Flagpoles
- 1992 – Repair to corner, clapboards & paint (\$125)
- 1992 – Painted exterior (Connelly, \$4600)
- 1993 – Repaired plaster and painted first floor interior (\$3,295)
- 1994 – Installed electrical receptacles on lower floor
- 1999-2000 – Painted building exterior; re-glazed windows (Gosinski, \$8,150)
- 2002 – Painted exterior (Jon S. Lilley, \$8300)
- 2006 – Re-glazed and primed all windows; replaced 41 panes of glass (Keith & Kal, \$3,038)
- 2007 – Painted building exterior (Keith & Kal, \$8,427.00)
- 2008 – Shingled roof with 30-year architectural shingles (Mitchell, \$13,360)
- 2012 – Reset and leveled front granite steps
- 2019 – Vapor Barrier installed (December 19-20) and basement windows sealed. (Wet Basements Solutions, \$5,500)
- 2020 – Windows restored (June – November) Stephen Decatur \$36,166
- 2020 – New ADA-compliant ramp with grading – Woodhams Carpentry \$4,675
- 2021 – Clapboard replacement/repair – Cameron Lorden \$66,000
- 2022 – Exterior painting – John Thompson \$32,500
